

VIVA DALLAS! Reports Record Attendance of over 20,000

DALLAS, TX - The Greater Dallas Hispanic Chamber of Commerce reported today its annual Hispanic business expo *VIVA Dallas!* broke previous attendance records by attracting more than 20,000 participants over the weekend.
